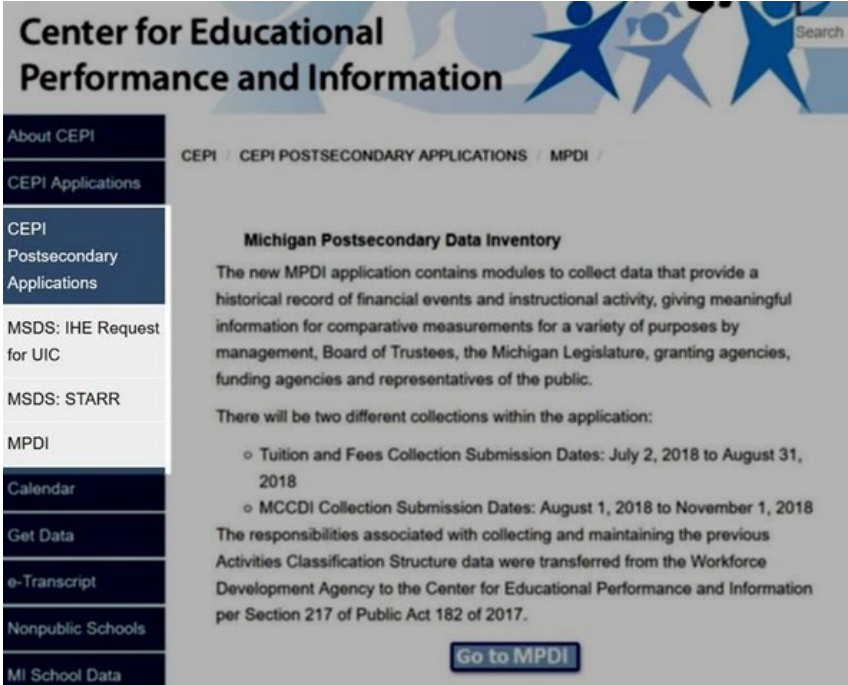

The [CEPI Postsecondary Applications Web Page](#) has been reformatted as the applications for data collection have expanded. You can now navigate the web page by selecting the link for the appropriate postsecondary data collection.



Tuition and Fees

The Tuition and Fees Collection within the Michigan Postsecondary Data Inventory application opens today, July 2. As specified in the State School Aid Act, colleges must submit tuition and fees data by Aug. 31, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. EDT, when the collection closes. The collection will not have a post closure grace period, which means there will be no data modifications allowed after this date. The [CEPI Postsecondary Applications Web Page](#) has been updated with the 2017-18 MPDI Data Manual.

To help ensure the accuracy of Tuition and Fees data, CEPI will perform data quality checks toward the end of the collection cycle. There will be one window for the Tuition and Fees Collection:

Mid-Collection Snapshot Tuesday, Aug. 14 (to be sent Aug. 20)

The mid-collection data quality will inform you of possible anomalies in data submitted in the current collection, up to that point in time, and allows colleges time to correct issues in the current collection, before it closes.
