MOTION by Graham, seconded by Cameron, to suspend Respondent's license for a minimum period of one (1) day and until he undergoes a Health Professional Recovery Program (HPRP) substance abuse and mental health evaluation and enters into a monitoring agreement, if recommended, in the matter of James Thomas Quinlan, M.D.

Respondent's license shall be automatically reinstated when the Department receives satisfactory evidence from the HPRP verifying either that 1) Respondent has entered into a disciplinary non-confidential monitoring agreement with the HPRP and that the HPRP has endorsed Respondent as safe to practice, or that 2) the HPRP has determined that Respondent does not require treatment monitoring.

Upon automatic reinstatement, Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year with the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Respondent shall comply with his HPRP monitoring agreement, if recommended.
- 2) Respondent shall comply with the Public Health Code.

Additionally, Respondent shall be assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 payable prior to reinstatement.

If Respondent's period of suspension exceeds six (6) months, he must petition for reinstatement.

Max Hoffman introduced himself and spoke on the newly enacted sex offender statutes and how they will impact licensees.






