Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disabilities, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.

4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the soldier should be denied information from or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally unobtainable would be made available to persons who might perjure their hands upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier.
