- Remarks (continued):
1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.
3. Applications from individuals and historians, for information from this statement of service to the official records of the Armies of the United States. Exemptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials custodian of the official records of the Armies of the United States, for the purpose of the Army, who is the individual being appealed to apply for the information to The Adjutant General of the Army, who is the official record keeper of the Armies of the United States.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the would be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally obtainable by said soldier should be denied information from, or access to, the injury of the soldier.
5. Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.
