MSDS: Documentation Update for New EC Program Code

Early Childhood (EC) Program code 19, Section 32p(4) Home Visitation, is available in the EC Programs Component as of March 15. This code should be submitted for children birth to age 6, or kindergarten entry who are experiencing factors that place them at risk of not achieving success in school, and are being served in home visitation programs. This characteristic may not be available within each individual student information system, but can be manually input in a child's record in the Michigan Student Data System (MSDS). It will be accepted if uploaded in the Early Childhood End-of-Program (EOP) 2017 schema. For the 2017-18 school year, this code will be included in all EC collections documentation.

MSDS: Guidance with UICs
