Upon reinstatement, Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year with the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Respondent shall comply with her HPRP monitoring agreement, if recommended.
- 2) Respondent shall submit quarterly employer reports.

Additionally, Respondent shall be assessed a fine of \$250.00 payable within sixty (60) days of the effective date of the Order.

If Respondent's period of suspension exceeds six (6) months, she must petition for reinstatement.
