1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.

2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.


