This is a reminder that in accordance with [The State School Aid Act of 1979](#), Section 222, **'Independent auditor's management letter and annual audited accounting of all general and current funds income and expenditures including audits of college foundations'** (financial statements) are due to the Center for Educational Performance and Information (CEPI) **no later than** close of business on Tuesday, November 15, 2016.

Of additional note, within the text of the aforementioned legislation, postsecondary institutions in the State of Michigan **are required** to post this information on their website under the Budget Transparency icon link.
