- The Mid-Collection Data Quality snapshot deadline is the end of the day on **Nov. 15**. To ensure your REP data are included in the analysis, records must be updated prior to the snapshot.

Districts and charter schools are required to evaluate their teachers and administrators, and to report a rating of Highly Effective, Effective, Minimally Effective, or Ineffective. Statewide, approximately 99% of Michigan teachers and administrators received a rating of either Effective or Highly Effective for the last school year.
