of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.

is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating estate is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.

to individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service is to be furnished only to the applicant directed to apply for the information to The Adjutant General of the Army, who is the custodian of the records of the Armies of the United States. Exceptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials of patriotic societies and associations when it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively for historical or statistical purposes, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or indirectly, or in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, or to the injury of the soldier.

Before provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the deceased are to be furnished from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally unobtainable from the Government to persons who might perpetrate frauds upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier.

As contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is to be furnished from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.

Some papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the form of the enlistment paper.
