operation, care being taken to insure that the mark is properly located on both the original and the duplicate. (See Instruction 5.)

3. If the applicant has had service requisite for the defensive sector clasp, as described in the Victory Medal circular, the defensive sector in which he served will be specified, with dates.

4. If the applicant is not entitled to a battle clasp for participation in major operation or for service in a defensive sector, but has served overseas in any of the countries and during the respective periods specified in the Victory Medal circular, he will place an "X" in the space in front of the country or countries served in.

5. If the applicant is in doubt as to his claim for participation in major operations or service in a defensive sector, or other character of service, he should explain in detail as to locations, dates, and organizations with which he served at the time, in the space for remarks on the back of the original.

6. The applicant will sign in ink, using his first Christian name, middle initial, and surname. Both original and duplicate will be signed, both being filled out identically, except that "Remarks" on back of original will not be reproduced on back of duplicate.

7. In case of applicants now in the military service, the present grade and organization of the applicant, as well as his name, will be entered on the line provided for the name of the person to whom the package is to be mailed, unless the applicant desires the medal sent to an address other than that of the station at which he is serving.

8. If forwarded approved to the Depot Officer, the direction "To The Adjutant General of the Army" and signature line thereunder will be stricken out, and the clasps approved will be stamped or written in the four spaces provided for the purpose, two on original and two on duplicate.

9. The form will be forwarded intact, no part of it being detached by the applicant or forwarding or approving officer.
