The records of this office show no active service for William Howe as an officer during the World War. The records show, however, that he was appointed a 2nd Lt., Inf. on Apr. 27, 1919 and served actively in the New Army until Aug. 26, 1919.

Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.
6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enlistment paper.
