MIOSHA STAFFING LEVELS

Section 332 of the FY '02 CIS appropriation bill, P.A. 119 of 2001, states that by February 15, 2002, the department shall submit a report of staffing levels within occupational safety and health for general industry safety inspectors, construction industry safety inspectors and industrial hygienists.

As of January 31, 2002, those staffing levels are as follows:
