Petitioner shall contact the HPRP and enter into a regulatory monitoring agreement and petition for reclassification of the limited license.

### **Scope of Practice**

A constituent inquiry into the ability to perform complete health and physical examinations were reviewed. Carpenter reported that a podiatrist's scope of practice as set forth in MCL

333.18001(1)(c) does not include a complete physical – it is limited to conditions of hand and feet as specifically outlined and does not permit the use or administration of anesthetics other than local. Discussion regarding delegation occurred. Carpenter reported that under MCL 333.16215, a licensee is authorized to delegate task, skills, and functions, only when those act, tasks, skills, and functions fall within his or her scope of practice.

The podiatry rules have been updated and are currently being reviewed by the Regulatory Affairs Officer.
