The official records at these Headquarters show that you were born October 22, 1898 at Adrian, Michigan; that you were accepted for enlistment at Chicago, Illinois and enlisted October 31, 1916. On April 6, 1917 you were serving with the 55th Co., 3rd Regiment at Cuba; joined Philadelphia, Pa., May 30, 1917, arriving in France July 3, 1917; joined Headquarters Co., 5th Regiment August 2, 1917 and participated in all the engagements in which the Marine Corps took part; and that you were gassed in action on October 3, 1918. Sailed from France March 20, 1919 arriving in the United States April 1, 1919. Discharged June 14, 1919 at Marine Barracks, Quantico, Va., a private, with character "Excellent".
