1. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the proper Government officials.

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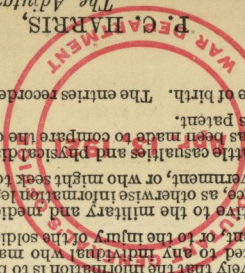
3. Application should be denied to the applicant directed to apply for the information to the Adjutant General of the Army, who is the official records of the United States. Exceptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials and associations when it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively for, or in the prosecution of, a claim against the Government, or to the injury of the soldier.

4. Except as provided in the foregoing, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the United States, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally unobtainable to persons who might perpetrate frauds upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier, data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.

5. Except the same form as those on the enlistment paper.

6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enlistment paper.
