tion because of the coolness with which he manoeuvred under fire and

because of the obstinacy with which he used his machine gun."

Russian St. George's Cross (fourth class), awarded by

Commander-in-Chief of all Russian Military and Naval Forces of North  
Russia, July 9, 1919, - "In recognition of gallant conduct in the

field and personal courage."
