Administrative Rules Committee

These high priority rule sets involve Pharmacy Technicians and the Pharmacy General Rules that address compounding.

Endorsement of the Pharmacy Compounding Accreditation Board (PCAB)

Motion by Moy-Sandusky, seconded by Fakh, to endorse the Pharmacy Compounding Accreditation Board (PCAB) as the accrediting standard compounding pharmacies must meet. This standard will be included in the draft administrative rules that are under review.

National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) District IV Meeting

Penny and Pignataro attended a 2.5 day District IV NABP meeting held at the Cleveland Clinic. Penny summarized the meeting, highlighting the topic of "collaborative care."

Department Update

Michael Siracuse introduced himself as the new attorney-analyst who will assist the Rules Committee and Board in the drafting of their administrative rules.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Rony Fournia stated that the LARA FAQ regarding pharmacy technicians is confusing. He also mentioned a bill that will push back the enforcement date of the pharmacy technician licensing requirement to June, 2015. Applicants will be able to apply for their licenses in December, but they will not be required to be licensed until June, 2015. He suggested having an FAQ on the website that would summarize the major changes whenever rules are promulgated.

Ahmed Zaher inquired about whether or not the people who grandfather into licensure will still be required to have a high school diploma. He also wondered whether or not the limited license will be tied to one pharmacy or if it can be used at multiple locations.

Jeff Kaufmann said the FAQ does not clarify the duties a cashier can do.

Jim Szyskowski wants to know how Kroger can submit paperwork for its employee-based training program.


