MSDS Collections Update to Resident LEA

Due to the recent legislative changes regarding Detroit Community Schools, the Resident LEA code reported in the Personal Demographics Component for students who live within the geographic boundaries of the former 82010 district will need to have their records updated to show the new 82015 district code. Records with Resident LEA code 82010 will receive errors when submitted to the MSDS.

EEM Updates for the Current School Year

If there have been any changes in your district or school entities since the beginning of the 2016-17 school year, please update the EEM prior to December 1, 2016. This includes closing entities from the 2015-16 school year and adding new entities for the 2016-17 school year. Incorrect EEM information may cause problems in data submissions, impact funding and grant allocations, and interfere with shipping and receipt of testing materials.

SE-4096 Pilot Submission Reminder

The pilot of the 2015-16 collection of Special Education Actual Costs (Form SE-4096) in the Financial Information Database (FID) closes on September 30, 2016. For participating districts, the deadline to submit data to the ISD was September 16. If you have not completed this process, please work with your ISD to make sure they can do their final approvals by September 30. If your ISD is not part of the pilot, MDE will submit your data on the ISD's behalf.

Several districts have submitted SE-4096 data via the FID application that had not signed up to be a pilot participant. As a reminder, all districts must submit the paper or Excel version of the SE-4096 to the MDE Office of Special Education, as has been the process in previous years.
