In this role, the analyst is part of a team that carries out the development and maintenance of a web site that meets the needs of the public while providing a tool for professional educators to improve student achievement.

Responsibilities include a wide range of assignments related to system requirements, user interface, system documentation, and assisting in the implementation of planning, design, development, testing, evaluation, operation, enhancement and maintenance functions (60% of duties). The position also includes carrying out user administration, documentation, training and awareness, usability, data validation, and data visualization duties for the MI School Data site (35% of duties).
