If the civil fine is not paid within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order, then Respondent's license shall be suspended. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

ZANE ZIEGLER, LICENSE NO. 17-01-017979. EXPIRED 8-1-1988, DETROIT, MICHIGAN: COMPLAINT NO. 323429

MOTION: It was moved by Mr. VanDyken and supported by Mr. Vitto that the following penalty be assessed: A civil fine in the amount of \$1,000.00 made payable to the State of Michigan within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order for Complaint No. 323429. If the civil fine is not paid within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order, then Respondent's license shall be suspended. The motion carried by unanimous vote.
