Dear Father

I shall leave here this afternoon for Detroit Mich. to see the Adj. Genl. I have been honorable discharged the service for physical disability on account of not joining the Regt. sooner - to date from the 30<sup>th</sup> of Jan. - but have received a new commission as 1st Lieut. from the Governor of Mich. & expect to be reinstated in my former position. The 9<sup>th</sup> Army Corps is now on the way to Annapolis Md. & our Regt. will be here the last of this week. The Corps will have fifty three Regts. including thirteen colored and will co-operate with the Army of the Potomac under Burnside. I will write again when I get to Mich. & let you know where to direct my letters.
