Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is present.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information upon the government, or who might seek to injure the soldier would be made available to persons who might be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information available to the military and medical historians of the soldier should be denied by society or association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or indirectly and associations which it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively of partitive and philanthropic societies and associations to this rule may be made in the case of others.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be denied and the applicant directed to the appropriate authority for the information to The Adjutant General of the Army, who is the custodian of the official records of the Armed Forces of the United States. Exemptions to this rule may be made in the case of individuals aggrieved by society or association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or indirectly and associations which it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively of partitive and philanthropic societies and associations to this rule may be made in the case of others.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the preparation of a claim in which the State is solely concerned. Although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned, it may be used in the preparation of a claim against the Federal Government, except to the proper Government or a claim against the State.
