Cited in G. O. #2, 2nd Brig. Hq. France, aug.2, 1918 P6 for conspicuous Gallantry in action during the operations 18-25, July 1918 near Soissons when in charge of a machine gun squad showed utter disregard of personal danger in leading his men to the final objective, after gun crew had become casualties and himself severely wounded continued to operate the gun until relief was sent him. even then refusing to be evacuated until he was carried to his company commander to whom he gave most valuable information regarding the enemy and the location of their machine guns.
