The 1976 Quail Whistling Survey

Quail whistling counts were conducted on 34 routes during the first two weeks of June (Table 1). Numbers of quail heard dropped 12 percent from comparable routes run in 1975. We had anticipated more substantial losses this year because of the severe weather encountered over much of the quail range this past winter. In addition to snow accumulation and low temperatures during the January to mid-February period, the northern part of the quail range was beset by a severe ice storm in early March. Despite the winter weather, bobwhites survived in good numbers. In all, 27 counties had sufficient quail to be opened for hunting this fall (see map) -- only three less than the record 30 counties opened to quail hunting last year.

Counties having less than 10 quail heard per 20 mile route were not recommended for hunting. These included Oakland, Clinton and Saginaw -- counties that were hunted last year. Better populations continue to be found in the two southern tiers of counties.


