SID EOY 2016 is Now Open

The EOY 2016 SID application opened April 1. Districts may submit SID data now through 11:59 p.m. EDT, June 30, 2016. As a reminder, school districts are now required to report the number of bullying (including cyberbullying) incidents that occur at school or school-sponsored activities. MSDS Offline April 7-8

The MSDS will be offline beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Thursday, April 7 until approximately 5 p.m. EDT on Friday, April 8. During this maintenance window, we will be performing the Spring 2016 General Collection closeout process, including updating PEPE and Cohort information. Once the system is back online, the Spring 2016 DS4061s will be available for editing by ISD auditors.

MSDS Direct Certification Report Refresh: April 11

The report of students who are directly certified to receive free supplemental nutrition services will be refreshed Monday, April 11, using the following records:

- Early Roster Collection (nonpublic schools only) records that were resolved and error-free prior to April 7.
- Fall 2015 and Spring 2016 General Collection certified records.
- Student Record Maintenance records that were certified prior to April 7.

MSDS Spring Dates for Assessment and Accountability Reporting Purposes

The following message is being communicated on behalf of the Division of Accountability Services (DAS).

Spring 2016 Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) cut off dates and "As Of" dates for spring 2016 assessments are listed below for assessment and accountability reporting purposes.

WIDA ACCESS and WIDA Alternate ACCESS:

DAS will do a final pull of student enrollment and demographic information from the MSDS on May 2, 2016 for records with an "As Of" date on or before March 25, 2016. Any necessary Student Record Maintenance (SRM) in the MSDS should be submitted and certified by 5 p.m. on May 2, 2016 with the appropriate "As Of" date in order to be reflected in spring 2016 WIDA results for reporting and accountability purposes. It is important to make sure students demographics are correct, especially the LEP designation (to avoid invalidated tests), students that have exited your district have been exited in the MSDS and any new enrollments are entered in MSDS.

SAT, WorkKeys, M-STEP and MI-Access:
