6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enlistment paper.
5. Except the data contained on the first four pages of each record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the soldier should be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally obtainable would be made available to persons who might pervert it to the detriment, or who might seek to injure the soldier.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be denied and the application referred to The Adjutant General of the Army, who is the custodian of the official records of the Armies of the United States. Exceptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials by said society or association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or indirectly as a basis for, or in the prosecution of, a claim against the Government, or to the injury of the soldier.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.
