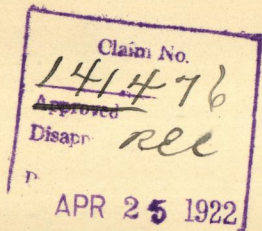

MEMORADUM.



1. This statement of service is furnished under the
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical purposes which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used by the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of information against the Government, except to the proper Government.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historical, should be denied and the applicant directed to apply for custody of the official records of the Armies of the United States. 4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information should be denied information from, or access to, the same, unless it would be made available to persons who might properly be expected to have access to it.
