1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be denied and the application referred to the Adjutant General of the Army, who is the sole authority for the application of the regulations of the United States. Exemptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials of the Federal Government, societies and associations of the Army, and public or semi-public organizations which have a definite and practical purpose.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the soldier should be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally obtainable would be made available to persons who might perpetrate frauds upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier.
5. Except the data detailed on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained with other records, except where an error of disengagement is evident.
6. Some enrollment papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enrollment paper.
