The records of the Bureau show that the above named man enlisted in the U. S. Navy 19 March 1914 at the Receiving Ship, Puget Sound, Wash., as an Apprentice Seaman to serve during minority until 22 August 1917; reported for active duty 19 March 1914 at the Receiving Ship, San Francisco, Calif., and was not released from active duty prior to date of discharge. Received an Honorable Discharge 22 May 1917 from the U.S.S. Dale at Cavite, P. I. He gave his home address at time of this enlistment as Snohomish, Washington.

Morse reenlisted 23 May 1917 on the U.S.S. Dale at Cavite, P. I., as a Gunner's Mate 3rd class to serve for the Duration of the War; reported for active duty 23 May 1917 on U.S.S. Dale; extended his enlistment for a period of one year, from 22 July 1919 to 21 July 1920; was not released from active duty prior to date of discharge. Received an Honorable Discharge 23 April 1920 from U.S.S. Galveston at Constantinople, Turkey as a Gunner's Mate 1st class. He gave his home address at time of this enlistment as Snohomish, Washington.
