MOTION by Bainbridge, seconded by Dix, to suspend Respondent's license for a minimum of one (1) day; Respondent must enter into a Health Professional Recovery Program (HPRP) monitoring agreement within six (6) months, if recommended, in the matter of Jason Teagle, R.T.

Respondent's license shall be automatically reinstated when the Department receives satisfactory evidence from the HPRP verifying either that (1) Respondent has entered into a disciplinary confidential monitoring agreement with the HPRP and that the HPRP has endorsed Respondent as safe to practice, or that (2) the HPRP has determined that Respondent does not require treatment monitoring. In the event Petitioner does not contact HPRP, and is not endorsed safe to practice, within six (6) months, the license shall remain suspended, and Respondent must apply for reinstatement.

Upon reinstatement, Respondent shall be placed on probation for one (1) year with the following term and condition:

- a. Must comply with HPRP.

Additionally, a fine shall be assessed in the amount of \$500.00, payable prior to reinstatement of license.




