Dear parents

I thought I would write you another leter to let you know that I am a live though not well. I have not got any leters from any of you since I have ben here which has ben every since the batle of peryvill and I have writen 4 or 5 times.

I had got quite well and had ben nersing the sick some time and I got the mezels and got up quite smart and was taken down a gain and have had a diarhee and am quite weeke but I think I shall be up in a fiew days. we are in a good hospítal. I want you to send me 5 dolars and some postage stamps. send me united states money as they do not like Michigan money. I have not got one cent and I need some very much. if you send it, send it the way you think best. direct to Danvill Kantucky Hospital No 1. do not put on the regiment or co. if you do it will go to the regiment. write as soon as you get this for I want to hear from you very much. your s in love from your sun. Albert Comstock
