1. This statement of service is furnished under the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.
  2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the State.
  3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be denied and the statement and statistics, for information from this statement of service
  4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the soldier should be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legibly inscribed on the first four lines and thereafter in full, or otherwise, would be made available to persons who might prepare frauds upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier.
  5. Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error of description is patent.
  6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment, while others show date of birth. The dates recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enlistment paper.
