Subject: Direct Certification Report Refreshed March 7

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The report of students who have been directly certified to receive free supplemental nutrition services was refreshed Friday, March 7 and is now available in the Michigan Student Data System. The following student records were included in the source file for this refresh:

- Fall 2013 General Collection certified records
- Student Record Maintenance 2013-2014 records that were certified prior to March 5
- Early Roster Collection (nonpublic schools only) records that were resolved and error-free prior to March 5.

Public schools: As a reminder, users will receive a certification-level error if a directly certified student is reported in the Spring General Collection as eligible for reduced-price meals/milk instead of free meals/milk. It is recommended to run the Direct Certification Report and verify that any newly matched students (3/4/2014 matched date) are reported with code "1" (Free) instead of "2" (Reduced) in the Supplemental Nutrition Eligibility (SNE) characteristic. You may obtain a list of all students reported in the collection as "Reduced" by running the "Economically Disadvantaged Students" report (found under the General Reports menu) and filtering on the SNE column.
