French Croix de Guerre with gilt star, under Order No. 14,381 "D" dated Mar. 14, 1919, General Headquarters, French Armie of the East, with the following citation. "He was constantly under a very violent enemy fire on Aug. 30, 1918, when in command of an engineer detachment in charge of clearing the streets of Juvisy in order to permit the passage of the artillery and infantry going to the attack to the east of the village. His conduct, his coolness and his good sense were such that the streets were quickly opened, permitting the passage of the troops without delay." Residence at enlistment: Houghton, Michigan
