I came out of the Confederacy on the 1st of this month and arrived here last night via. Wilmington on the Steamer "Entupe" [?] have got clean clothes and something to eat once more & shall be at home soon. My application for Leave of Absence was forwarded this morning. I am well and enjoying my liberty - and can give you some idea of what there is left of the Rebs and their cause when I get home.
