1. The above named man enlisted in the United States Navy 8 October 1914, Naval Recruiting Station, Detroit, Michigan, as machinist mate second class, to serve four years. He was appointed Ensign (T) in the United States Navy on 19 January 1918 and served as an officer until 20 August 1919 when he reverted to enlisted status and was discharged with an Honorable Discharge the same day, while serving at the Receiving Ship, New York, N.Y. as Chief Machinist's Mate.
