1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.

2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.

3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be made to the Adjutant General of the Army, who is the custodian of the official records of the United States. Exemptions to this rule may be made in the case of officials of patriotic and philanthropic societies and associations, who it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively by said society or association, and will not be used publicly nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or indirectly as a basis for, or in the prosecution of, a claim against the Government, or to the injury of the soldier.

4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information upon the Government, as otherwise mentioned in this statement, should be made available to persons who might perceive frauds upon the Government, or who might injure the soldier would be made available to the Adjutant General, or to access to, this statement of service, as otherwise mentioned in this statement, the data contained on the form should be made available to persons who might perceive frauds upon the Government, or who might injure the soldier. 5. Except the data contained on the form should be made available to battle casualties and disabled soldiers, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error of discrepancy is patent.
