

7. The service record with other records, except where age at enlistment, is different, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enlisted men paper.
8. The service record as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where age at enlistment, is different.
