Preceptorship Program Approval

MOTION by Husain, seconded by Anton-Athens, to accept the preceptorship program request of Dr. Paul James Constantino.

MOTION PREVAILED

Advisory Committee on Pain and Symptom Management (ACPSM) Presentation

Affholter shared a Michigan Advisory Committee on Pain and Symptom Management (ACPSM) 2013 CE/CME Recommendation via PowerPoint presentation with the Board and distributed a paper copy of both the CE/CME recommendation as well as the regulatory requirements per MCL 333.16204 and MCL 333.16204a. This 2013 recommendation updates the ACPSM's 2002 recommendation. She pointed out that the Michigan Board of Podiatric Medicine and Surgery "shall take into consideration the recommendation for that health care profession by the . . . advisory committee created in section 16204a."

MOTION by Holmes, seconded by Husain, to accept the ACPSM's recommendation to increase the required number of contact hours for pain and symptom management for renewal from one (1) to three (3) hours when the continuing education rules are opened for review in the future.

Affholter also made available the new MAPS poster, the ACPSM's pain tool kit for health professionals, and other pain related information.

Controlled Substances Advisory Commission (CSAC) Update

Kreitman noted the Controlled Substances Advisory Committee (CSAC) did not meet. He informed of the reclassification of Hydrocodone Combinations Products (HCP) that went into effect October 6, 2014.

Health Professional Recovery Program Update – Susan Bushong

Susan Bushong, HPRP Contract Administrator, provided an overview of the HPRP and the annual report.

Bushong also informed that a representative is needed for the Health Professional Recovery Committee (HPRC) to represent the Board of Audiology. Any interested and eligible individual may send their letter of interest and curriculum vitae to Susan Bushong at bushongs@michigan.gov. Board members cannot serve on the HPRC.

Department Update

Lind informed that no public was present during the Podiatry Public Rules Hearing. The next rulemaking process step will be Departmental approval.

Lind updated Board members that SB 597, a bill that requires all health professional licensees to complete training in recognizing the signs of Human Trafficking, has passed into law as Public Act 343 of 2014.

Kreitman and Lind explained that a request was made to the Board to address the use of pneumatic compression devices in Michigan. In accordance with the scope of practice for podiatrists in Michigan, the board unanimously agreed that compression therapy is a common treatment used by podiatrists in Michigan.

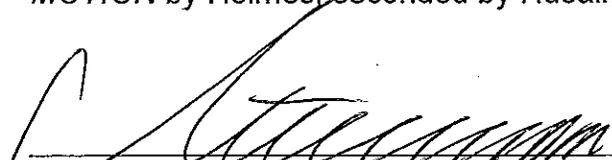

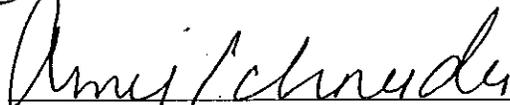
