Updated reports available to the public

- **[Grad/Dropout Rates](#)**. 2013-14 school year data is available to the public. The Grad/Dropout Rate report shows the percent of public high school students who, after beginning ninth grade four, five or six years ago, graduated or dropped out of school.
- **[Education Dashboard](#)**. Deficit district data, average salary data, and average class size (K-3) for 2013-14 are now available to the public. The Dashboard provides at-a-glance access to a variety of different metrics that can be used to see how a school, district, ISD, or even the whole state is performing.
- **[Quick Facts](#)**. 2014-15 school year data is now available to the public. The Quick Facts report provides an overview of the different types and counts of education buildings by state, intermediate school district, and district.
- **[Students Not Tested](#)**. 2013-14 school year data is now available to the public. The Students Not Tested spreadsheet provides summary information on students who were expected to participate in State standardized assessment, but who did not.

Note for Student Pathways users: High school fields available in the Basic Student Data File have been refreshed with 2013-14 [Graduation and Dropout \(GAD\)](#) data. If you recently requested this data, you may now see new high school exit statuses or updated demographic information.
