

Gratiot-Saginaw Counties Project

Size. 30,400 acres or $47\frac{1}{2}$ square miles.

Location. Central part of project is 12 miles east and 4 miles south of Ithaca; 12 miles west and 5 miles south of St. Charles; 30 miles from Saginaw; 48 miles from Flint; and 45 miles from Lansing.

Soil. No first-class in land solid blocks as large as 1 square mile.

Second-class land - 3440 acres, per acre value \$25 to \$50.

Third-class land - 3500 " , " " " \$20 to \$40.

Fourth-class land - 13,640 " , " " " \$15 to \$25.

Fifth-class land - 9820 " , " " " \$ 5 to \$15.

Cover. Wild or woodland (poplar, oak, elm, maple, etc.)
..... 17,570 acres or 58%

Cropped land 10,570 " or 34%

Idle cleared land 2,360 " or 8%

Game. Pheasants - plentiful, both in and on all sides of area.

Rabbits - Should be plentiful.

Beaver - Present in drainage ditches.

Fox Squirrel - Present.

Raccoon - Present.

Ruffed Grouse - Cover suitable.
