The Adjutant General.

1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution of a claim against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this statement of service should be denied and the application directed to apply to the Adjutant General of the Army, who is the custodian of the official records of the Armed Forces.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical histories of the soldier should be denied information from the Adjutant General, the Secretary of War, or any individual who may use it directly or indirectly for association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it directly or by said society and philosophical societies and associations when it is known positively that the information is to be used exclusively for the benefit of a claimant, or in the injury of the soldier.
5. Except the data contained on the first four lines and the service record, as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.
6. Some enrollment papers show age at enrollment, while others show date of birth. The entries recorded herein are in the same form as those on the enrollment paper.
