Murphy was enlisted at Columbus Barracks, Ohio April 19, 1917 and deserted the service at Camp Meade, Md., was apprehended by the civil authorities at Adrian, Mich Dec. 17, 1917; tried by General Court Martial and sentenced to be dishonorably discharged, discharge being suspended until release from confinement, and died Oct. 17, 1918 while in confinement.
