CEPI Master Calendar Update

Postsecondary Data Use

In partnership with Michigan colleges and universities, a decision was made during the summer and fall of 2019 to modify how the data CEPI receives from the National Student Clearinghouse is merged with STARR data. This decision was based on several conversations, along with research and analysis.

After implementing these changes, it was discovered that removing the historical NSC data for the public and independent institutions of higher education resulted in a significant and unintended drop in overall postsecondary student enrollment and award record counts. Since neither the STARR nor NSC data source has a complete history of the data, too much information was lost when limiting either source. Recently, CEPI has expanded our partnership with a team at the Michigan Education Data Center from the University of Michigan to revise the merging rules handling these conflicting data.

CEPI has begun to reprocess the 2018-19 data and plans to have new reporting outputs available for public consumption before the end of September.

MI School Data Website Redesign Coming Soon

This summer, CEPI will release the updated MI School Data. The redesigned website will include all the reports that you are used to seeing on the site, as well as exciting new features that will extend the ways to explore Michigan’s education data. MI School Data’s updated look and feel are designed to quickly connect users with the information they need quickly and easily.

Secure MI School Data users will receive early access to the beta version of the redesigned website two weeks before the public release. These users will receive instructions via email on how to access the beta version. The site will be under embargo until the public release. Once the redesigned website is public, secure users will have access to the previous version of MI School Data for two months.
