

Exceptions to this rule may be made in the case of philanthropic societies and associations when it is known positively that the information is to be used for the benefit of such society or association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any individual who may use it as a basis for, or in the prosecution of, a claim against the Government, or to the injury of the soldier.

hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relative to the military and medical history of the Army shall be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, as otherwise information legally obtainable from the records made available to persons who might perpetrate frauds upon the Government, or who might seek to injure the soldier.

Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from this statement with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent.
