The 1977 Quail Whistling Survey

Quail whistling counts were conducted on 34 routes during the first two weeks of June (Table 1). Numbers of quail heard dropped almost 40 percent from comparable routes run in 1976. We anticipated substantial losses again this year because of the severe weather encountered over much of the quail range this past winter. Despite the winter weather, bobwhites survived in adequate numbers to recommend that 23 counties be opened for hunting this fall (see map) -- only four less than the 27 counties opened to quail hunting last year.

Counties having less than 10 quail heard per 20 mile route were not recommended for hunting. These included: Barry, Eaton, Genesee, Gratiot, Macomb, Livingston, and Tuscola, all of which were hunted last year. Three additional counties -- Oakland, Ottawa, and Saginaw -- qualified to be added to the area open to hunting in 1977.

We have consistently made the point that hunters should be allowed to take quail when numbers build up over a period of mild winters because a "hard" winter can reduce the population severely. That happened last winter. All seven counties to be closed, which were open last year, are north of the two southern tiers of counties. Even in those counties where quail numbers have been the best, such as Hillsdale and Lenawee for example, counts were greatly reduced this year. We can only forecast a poorer than average season for the Michigan quail hunter this year.
