The records of the Bureau show that the above named man enlisted in the U.S. Navy 14 March, 1913, as Coal Passer, at the Recruiting Station, Cincinnati, Ohio, giving his address as 511 West Short Street, Lexington, Kentucky; issued an Ordinary Discharge, by reason of Purchase 10 July, 1915, as Fireman second class, from the U.S.S. South Carolina, Newport, R.I.; re-enlisted in the U.S. Navy 15 June, 1917, at the Recruiting Station, Detroit, Michigan, giving his home address as 616 Upper Street, Lexington, Kentucky; issued an Honorable Discharge 27 September, 1919, from the U.S.S.
