1. This statement of service is furnished under the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 11, 1919.
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical and statistical purposes, although it may be used in adjudicating claims in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used before a court of justice or in support of any claim against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of any information that may be used in the prosecution against the Government, except to the proper Government officials.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historians and statisticians, for information from this should be denied and the applicant directed to apply for the information to The Adjutant General, custodian of the official records of the Armies of the United States. Exceptions to this rule may be made of patriotic and philanthropic societies and associations when it is known positively that the information by said society or association, and will not be made public nor communicated to any person or indirectly as a basis for, or in the prosecution of, a claim against the Government, or any other purpose.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons seeking information relating to the service of a soldier should be denied information from, or access to, this statement of service, or any other record would be made available to persons who might perpetrate frauds or other offenses.
5. Except the data contained on the first four lines and the date of enlistment, the statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record of the soldier, and the service record would be made available to persons who might perpetrate frauds or other offenses.
6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment, and some show date of birth. The age at enlistment should be used in the statement of service, except where the date of birth is given in the same form as those on the enlistment papers.
