Remarks: Under the provisions of the Act of Congress, approved March 2, 1929 (Public 950, 70th Congress), in the administration of any laws conferring rights, privileges or benefits, upon honorably discharged soldiers, their widows and dependent children, the above-named soldier shall hereafter be held and considered to have been honorably discharged October 19, 1918.
